



Summer Employment Opportunity - Camp Recreation Program Leaders

Plast Toronto is seeking to hire **Camp Recreation Program Leaders** to strengthen our ability to assist camp staff in their work with children and youth and provide them with comprehensive resources. There are three (3) positions available. These jobs are funded by the Government of Canada through the Canada Summer Jobs program.

To be eligible, candidates:

- must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment
- must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*
- must have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations
- should have an interest in a career in program development, education, recreational program management

**International students and those on CUAET visas are not eligible.*

Duties: Working under the supervision of the Executive Director, the Camp Recreation Program Leaders will work together and cooperatively with Recreation Programmers to plan and monitor recreational summer programs and camps for children and youth (ages 6-17), and develop program materials, manuals, guides, and digital resources for program volunteers to support the planning and implementation of the summer programs and camps.

In cooperation with other team members:

- develop and curate a selection of age-appropriate activities for children aged 6-11 or 12-17, new materials based on Plast guidelines for use by staff in the camp setting
- review existing resources, to identify gaps and add new resources to be used for group meetings and camp programs
- assist with the registration process for summer camps and programs
- assist with coordinating logistics of events and summer camps, as necessary
- schedule activities, keep logs, maintain records and prepare reports
- assist with volunteer training and orientation

- assist with assessing future program needs through internal surveys and focus group interviews with current and past group leaders and provide post-camp analysis

Requirements:

- Effective communication skills (written and oral)
- Comfortable in dealing with volunteers
- Excellent organizational and time management skills, ability to meet timelines
- Knowledge of Word, Excel and ability to operate office equipment - candidate must provide own laptop
- Attentive to detail, responsible
- Demonstrated ability to work independently, and collaboratively as part of a team
- Knowledge of Plast programs or scouting
- Proficiency in English and Ukrainian
- Interest in/knowledge of program development and/or education would be an asset

Term and working hours: Up to 16 weeks at 35 hrs per week. Generally Monday to Friday during office hours, however some weeknight and weekend availability may be required.

Place of work: predominantly Plast Huculak Centre at 516 The Kingsway, Toronto with some travel to camp settings as needed and/or remote work as required.
