Summer Employment Opportunity – Pool Lifeguard(s) Plast Sich, Grafton ON

Please note that we will review resumes as they are received and will offer the position as soon as suitable candidates are found.

Plast Toronto is seeking to hire a full time Lifeguard for its facility in Grafton ON. This job is funded by the Government of Canada through the Canada Summer Jobs program. We are also accepting resumes from those interested in part time Lifeguarding.

To be eligible, candidates:

- must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment;
- must have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations;
- must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*

*International students and those on CUAET visas are not eligible.

Duties: Reporting to the Facilities Manager, the Lifeguard(s) will work in cooperation with Camp Cleaner and Caretaker and, when applicable, Camp Administration & Staff to ensure the safety of all who are using the pool.

As lifeguard you will be responsible for the following:

- Enforce the rules and regulations of the pool.
- Advise management of unsafe and unsanitary conditions.
- Perform daily routine chores and maintenance to ensure neat and orderly appearance.
- Assist and communicate with users in a professional and courteous manner and ensure a positive public relations image.
- Filtration system and water chemistry, including:
 - regulating pool chemicals as necessary
 - daily testing of chemical content of water prior to swim and maintaining log
 - notifying Camp Custodian or Facilities Manager of any needs or deficiencies with regards to filtration system or water chemistry
- Safety and Supervision, including:

- Supervising scheduled daily swim periods
- In cooperation with Camp Cleaner or Custodian, maintaining cleanliness of pool and pool house (change rooms and restroom facilities)
- Administering swim tests for all minors attending camps as necessary throughout the summer
- Ensuring users of the pool, including cottagers, visitors, campers and camp staff are following all relevant safety protocols
- Clearing the pool of non-camp participants prior to daily camp swimming sessions

Requirements/Qualifications:

- Previous experience as a lifeguard
- Current Standard First Aid with CPR-C Certification, which must be dated no more than 2 years from the certification date
- Current NLS Certificate [National Lifeguard Service], which must be dated no more than 2 years from the certification date
- Effective communication skills (written and oral)
- Comfortable dealing with people of all ages
- Attentive to detail, responsible, takes initiative
- Ability to work independently as well as in a team

Term: 14-35 hours/week for up to 10 weeks (Between June 22-September 2)

Hourly wage: \$19.05/hr (on-site shared accommodation available; meals provided July 7-August 3)
